Stroke Statistics

- In 2018, 1 in every 6 deaths from cardiovascular disease was due to stroke.
- Someone in the United States has a stroke every 40 seconds. Every 4 minutes, someone dies of stroke.
- Every year, more than 795,000 people in the United States have a stroke. About 610,000 of these are first or new strokes.
- About 185,000 strokes—nearly 1 of 4—are in people who have had a previous stroke.
- About 87% of all strokes are ischemic strokes, in which blood flow to the brain is blocked.
- Stroke-related costs in the United States came to nearly \$46 billion between 2014 and 2015. This total includes the cost of health care services, medicines to treat stroke, and missed days of work.
- Stroke is a leading cause of serious long-term disability. Stroke reduces mobility in more than half of stroke survivors age 65 and over.

1.Comprehensive Assessment – Care Coordinator will assess at the hospital, facility or home to determine overall condition, diagnosis, prognosis, limitations and overall care upon discharge.

2.Caregiver Training – Right Accord will schedule caregiver training at the facility to ensure proper orientation and implementation of care.

3.Develop Care Plan – a nurse led comprehensive care plan with focus on safety, client limitations, any paralysis, aphasia or transfer issues.

4.Collaboration with Other Health Care Members – Caregivers will work with RN, PT, OT, ST, RT to reinforce exercises and other therapy as demonstrated.

5.Follow Up Care – Right Accord team goal is to reduce the incidence of hospital readmissions, avoid complications and improve quality outcomes.
